2001 JAMBOREE VIDEO ORDER FORM NOW AVAILABLE

You can now reserve your copy of the official 2001 National Scout Jamboree video.

Videos will be available in VHS format and are copy-protected. Each video is \$21.95, including postage and handling charges (\$24.95 after August 1, 2001). Outside the United States, add \$12 for each additional video for postage. **Note:** The 1993 and 1997 official national Scout jamboree videos are still available for \$21.95 each, or \$30 for both.

The video is the perfect souvenir for Scouts attending the jamboree and will make a wonderful present for parents, letting them see the full range of jamboree activities. It also makes a nice gift for friends of Scouting who help make the jamboree experience possible.

Discount

A bulk discount on the 2001 video is available. Each individual order for eight or more 2001 National Scout Jamboree videos will receive one video FREE for each eight videos ordered. For example, one free video for eight purchased, two free videos for 16 purchased, three free videos for 24 purchased, four for 32, etc. Use the official order form in this *Bulletin*.

POINTS OF THE SCOUT LAW CONTEST

What do the points of the Scout Law mean to you? Scouts are invited to write an essay about the meaning of a point of the Scout Law.

Enter as many times as you like (one point - trustworthy, loyal, helpful, etc. - per entry, please). Your *Boy Scout Handbook* has some great examples. The 12 winners will participate on stage as part of the candlelight ceremony at the Sunday, July 29, arena show.

This contest is for jamboree Scout participants only, so you must be 18 or younger to enter. See the entry form in this *Bulletin*.

Points of the Scout Law Contest Prizes

The Points of the Scout Law contest will award 36 prizes - three prizes for essay winners of each point of the Scout Law. All contest winners will receive e-mail-based communication devices courtesy of Vtech Connect, Inc.

1. The contest awards 12 first-place prizes to the 12 essay winners of each point of the Scout Law (one winner for each point of the Scout Law). Each winner's prize is an **e-Mail PostBox Express**. The device lets you send and receive your own personal e-mail anytime, anywhere a telephone jack is available. It's small enough to fit in your pocket. No computer is needed; just plug into any phone jack and go.
2. Each winner's jamboree Scoutmaster will receive a prize. The Scoutmaster's prize is an **e-Mail PostBox Companion**, the desk model version of the **e-Mail PostBox Express**. The **Companion** lets the user send and receive e-mail anytime, anywhere a phone jack is available. No computer is needed.
3. Twelve runner-up prizes will be awarded (one prize for each point of the Scout Law). Each runner-up will receive the **Vtech Helio**, a hand-held personal digital assistant. The **Helio** provides recorded voice messaging, tracking and prioritizing important items, and storing names and numbers. You can use it as a sketch pad or download and draft e-mail.

SPECIAL DIETARY NEEDS

The jamboree Food Service does not have the capability of satisfying all the many special dietary needs of those attending the jamboree. If you have special food needs because of medical reasons, you should first advise the jamboree chief medical officer of your situation and ascertain that you are eligible to attend the jamboree.

After medical permission is granted, or if your special dietary needs are of a religious nature other than kosher, you should plan to make your own arrangements for the satisfaction of that need. **You can do this by bringing a supply of nonperishable food with you, much as you would with medicine. You can also buy food at local supermarkets in Bowling Green or Fredericksburg, Virginia.**

PROCEDURE FOR LATE MEDICAL FORMS

As late medical forms are received, affix the label to the original and mail it to the jamboree medical officer at the address on the first page of this *Bulletin*. If a council does not have a label for the form, it should mail the form without one. Remember to have the Scout or leader keep a copy of the medical form. Medical forms should not be sent to the national office after June 15. These forms should be hand-carried to the jamboree site to be given to the subcamp medical officer during check-in.

USE OF THE JAMBOREE EMBLEM

The embroidered emblem of the 2001 National Scout Jamboree reflects the jamboree theme, "Strong Values . . . Strong Leaders."

The trademarks and logos of the Boy Scouts of America are protected by a 1910 act of Congress (36 U.S.C. 27) as well as by a variety of registrations with the U.S. Patent and Trademark Office. The 1910 act specifically gives the Boy Scouts of America the sole and exclusive right to use its "emblems, badges, descriptive, and designating marks" in connection with carrying out its purposes. Local councils are free to use the jamboree emblem in all their **printed** materials. No changes are to be made when printing the emblem.

No embroidered emblems or pins using the jamboree emblem are to be made by outside vendors, nor is the emblem to be incorporated into any other emblem or manufactured item without the approval of the Jamboree Division.

SPECIAL SCOUTMASTER AWARD

A special award will be available for jamboree Scoutmasters whose entire troops earn all five activity patch segments. The award for Scoutmasters is a circular patch that goes around the jamboree patch. It is called the Five for Five award. The segments Scouts can earn are the 5K Run, Duty to God, Activities, Activity Centers, and Outback Centers.

SUPPORT AND EQUIPMENT TRUCKS AND TRAILERS

Support and equipment trucks and trailers must rendezvous with the contingent buses before arrival at Fort A. P. Hill. Due to congestion near the jamboree site contingents should rendezvous no less than five miles from the gate of entry. **Troops and equipment must arrive together.** All vehicles and trailers are unloaded by the troop members and two adult leaders. Then they are released either to leave the jamboree site or to be parked in a storage area for the duration of the jamboree.

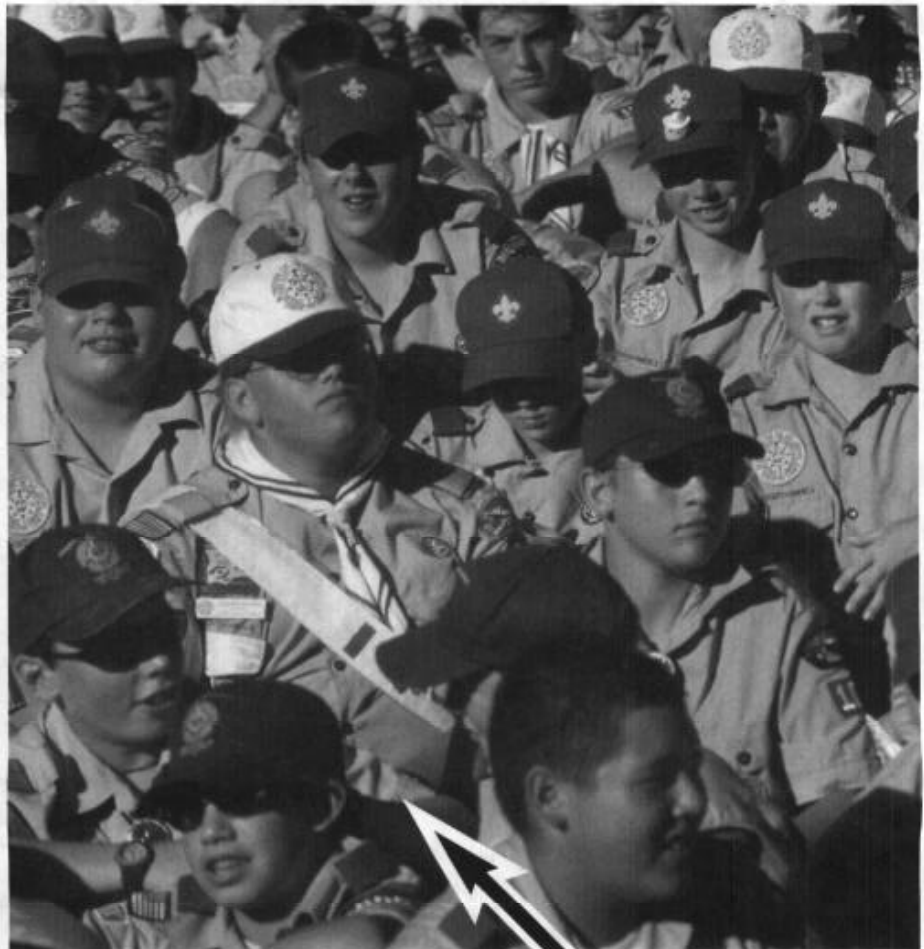
